Windows Underwater is open to both members and non-members of the Guild of Natural Science Illustrators Northwest. Up to three original pieces in any medium will be accepted. Subject matter must fit the theme of Pacific Northwest marine life, special consideration will be given to underwater depictions. Art work must be ready to hang, framed if necessary; minimum size of 8 x 10 inches and a maximum size of 24 x 36 inches. Artists have the option of offering their work for sale. If selling, artists may opt to donate any % to the Marine Science & Technology Center.
