Accepted work will primarily be wall hung with 2-D

- 2-D maximum size 40" height x 36" wide
- A limited number of works up to 72" wide will be considered
- 2-D works must be ready to install with a hanging wire and "D" rings – no saw tooth fixtures
- 3-D sculptural works can be displayed – both large and medium sizes
- No work previously exhibited with at this venue
- All wall hung media accepted excluding work that requires electricity

***Label each file according to what type of document it is:***

PLEASE FOLLOW THIS! It is time consuming to process documents not labeled properly.

EXAMPLE:

- Smith\_Jane\_image list.doc (Name, address, phone, email, website – image information - title, medium, size, year, price or insurance value if NFS)
- Smith\_Jane\_title of work.jpg image
- Smith\_Jane\_bio. / resume./ statement doc (all in one document)

Attach jpegs of available artwork – low resolution to be viewed on line only

Use the following Jpeg format instructions:

- Each Jpeg should be saved at 72 dpi
- Use maximum image size of 1200px on the longest dimension
- Limit each jpeg to a maximum file size of 2MG
- LABEL JPEG WITH YOUR NAME AND TITLE OF ART WORK – This helps me identify the art without having to re-label it myself. Example: Smith\_Jane\_Title of Work.jpg

Include an art work list with the following details for EACH jpeg. (Smith\_Jane\_title.doc)

- Title
- Medium
- Size H" x W" x D"
- Year completed
- Price or Insurance Value if NFS (not for sale)

Attach resume, bio and **artist statement regarding this particular theme and exhibition.** Please include all this information in one document, maximum pages 3. These documents are for the artist binder. Do not include your address if you don't want the public to see it. Include any contact info you want your audience to connect to you and your work.

**Era Living Exhibitions:**

The artist receives 100% from sales at Era Living locations – no commission is taken. Sales are made directly between you and your client. Postcards are generated for each show and promotional material sent to print and online media sources. Opening receptions are held for each exhibition and artists may be invited by the curator to participate in artist talks.
