

**Basic Materials List** 

## SUPPLIES:

- Arches hot press 140 lb watercolor paper 9x14" or close – no substitutions

- 1" or larger Artist's tape (this is not masking or painter's tape but low tack/acid-free tape, white or black)

- Gator board or masonite (large enough to attach the Arches paper to)

- Small piece of transfer paper

- Small T-square

- Watercolor brushes, Rounds - Look for a large brush that comes to a nice point. I recommend a **quill brush** like **Black Gold 311** brushes at Daniel Smith, sizes 000, 2, 4. These are larger than regular brushes- make sure they are **BG 311 and not the regular sized Black Gold brushes.** 

- Small liner brush - a 000 size that has bristles around 1/2" long

- Watercolor palette for mixing

- Daler Rowney Pro White- a white gouache that comes in a small glass bottle

- Watercolors –see separate list. Please bring all the colors you may already own or that you like so you can use them as we work on this project.

- water jar

- Kneadable eraser
- **Black Micron pens** or any other brand of pen that is waterproof (Pitt, Copic), .02mm or .03mm.
- **FW** Acrylic Artists Ink black

- **Medium round brush** to use for inking, **not your best brush** as the ink will ruin a fine watercolor brush

- Electric or battery operated pencil sharpener

- Stabilo Aquarellable Pencil (White) -

- Electric or battery eraser (optional)

- Krylon Workable Fixative (optional)

- Prismacolor Colored Pencils – see separate list Please bring all the colors you may already own or that you like so you can use them as we work on this project.

- Stencil Brush – or any short bristled, stiff brush. The cheaper the better.
