Juried Art Exhibition
Call to Artists

The Guild of Natural Science Illustrators Northwest Art Exhibition “Natural Musings” will be open for entries on February 1st, 2018. This is a juried exhibition as required by the Washington State Convention and Trade Center. Selected entries will be displayed at the WSCTC 2AB Lobby at 800 Convention Place, Seattle, Washington from Saturday June 30th, 2018 until Tuesday September 25th, 2018.

Entry forms, prospectus, and framing guidelines will be available on the GNSINW website by February 1st, 2018 when submissions will open. Entries will be accepted until March 12th, 2018. The goal of this exhibition is to exhibit works from as many of the guild’s members as possible within the limits of the given space.

Artists must be members of GNSINW and will be able to submit up to two original works for consideration. Works should range in size from 44” minimum to 120” maximum total framed dimensions. These dimensions should be used as a guideline, not absolute, so if your work is larger or smaller it will still be considered on a space basis. There will be no entry fee but accepted artists may be asked to help defray printing costs for brochures and informational posters required for the exhibition.

Artworks should promote the Guild’s mission of inspiring and educating viewers, as well as providing valuable information about scientific studies. The art should display a high degree of accuracy and workmanship as well as be artistically stimulating. Subjects must also be suitable for all-ages audiences.
