



WSCC EXHIBITION FRAMING GUIDELINES

Artwork must be framed in a professional manner. GNSINW reserves the right to exclude artwork that is not professionally presented or does not meet the general standards outlined below:

- Neutral mats should be used. A white or off-white is preferred. Gray, beige or black mats are considered neutral.
- Frames should be simple, of wood or metal, with a gallery frame profile preferred (this is an “L” shaped profile). Colors should be neutral. Black, copper, silver or gold are acceptable.
- Acrylic must be used on all artwork unless no covering is used.
- All artwork must be wired for hanging. Please be sure to check online sources for details about wire placement if you have questions.
- Protect artwork for transport and short term storage.
- Label artwork on back and wrapping materials with your name and title of piece.
